JOB SUMMARY:

This position is responsible for operating various equipment to assist with the completion of restoration projects in a safe, efficient, and professional manner while maintaining an exception standard of quality and value for our customers. High functioning equipment operators may have increased opportunities through onsite project & crew management.

MAJOR DUTIES OF POSITION:

- Operates equipment in order to advance construction and maintenance projects, drives vehicles over public roads, work sites, and other City property.
- Monitors immediate environment and work area to ensure the safety of operators, other coworkers, the equipment, and the public.
- Performs various tasks involving street, storm-water drainage, and/or right of way maintenance projects.
- Prepares road surfaces for asphalt application. Lays and smoothes asphalt; patches/repairs utility cuts and potholes in road surfaces.
- Lays or builds concrete forms for catch-basins, sidewalks and curbing; pours ditches, & catch basins, construct asphalt driveway tie-ins.
- Installs, repairs, and/or replaces water mains, service lines, hydrants, and related components of the distribution system.

SKILLS REQUIRED FOR THIS POSITION:

- Knowledge of city policies and procedures and safety rules and regulations.
- Skill in operating equipment such as tractor mower, dump truck, bulldozer, backhoe, and street sweeper,
- Skill in operating power tools such as chain saws and weed eaters.
- Ability to analyze situations to pinpoint problems and assist with solving those problems.
- Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships as required by work assignments.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to read, write and perform basic mathematical calculations at a level commonly associated with the completion of high school or equivalent.
- Must possess the appropriate Georgia motor vehicle operator's license (CDL preferred) to operate the appropriate equipment.
- Education and/or experience in the operation of the above listed machinery and a satisfactory display of skills in tree removal services.
